## WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

The Pre-Adolescent Diversion Project is designed for first-time juvenile offenders ages 8 to 14 years old and their families. Youth who have committed an offense are referred by Pima County Juvenile Court.

## WHAT DOES PADP INVOLVE?

Your family will attend a five week workshop series, which takes place on five consecutive Saturday mornings.

You will explore ways to:

- Handle conflicts
- Solve problems
- Manage anger
- Resist peer pressure
- Communicate more clearly



The workshops involve the entire family so everyone can learn together! The workshops also include parenting groups, offered in both English and Spanish, that discuss ways to influence a child's success through communication, positive recognition, and active supervision.
