Parenting can bring both joy and special challenges. Unfortunately, some parents face challenging obstacles, such as having a child with a developmental disability, coping with poverty, or coming from a history of abuse. Learning does not begin when children enter kindergarten. Research demonstrates that 90% of a child's brain development occurs between zero and five years. We focus on enhancing the quality of early childhood education to ensure that more children enter primary school prepared to succeed.

Adolescence can be especially challenging as youth grow into young adults. We partner with teens to increase their ability to bounce back from adversity, encouraging them to be leaders in their community, have a positive self-worth, and avoid risky behaviors and peer pressure.

Child & Family Resources' programs focus on building resiliency by promoting family success, school readiness, and youth empowerment to help improve the lives of Arizona's children and families. Our programs are funded through federal, state and local government contracts, program fees, grants, and private donations from individuals and businesses.
